**DAY 01: Nairobi**

Upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, you will be met and assisted. After a brief introduction, proceed to your hotel for leisure. Overnight at the Royal Orchid Hotel.

DAY 02: Nairobi - Masai Mara (approximately 5 ½ Hours Drive)

After breakfast, depart for the world famous Masai Mara National Reserve. Arrive at your camp for check-in and have lunch. The camp blends in perfectly with its surrounding hillside landscape. The accent here is on the Masai people and the wealth of wildlife, birdlife, and natural flora to be found in the fabled Masai Mara Game Reserve. Enjoy an afternoon 1600hrs game drive around the world famous Mara. Dinner and overnight stay at Mara Leisure Camp (B/L/D)

DAY 03: Masai Mara

Full day spent in the Mara with early morning 0630hrs and afternoon 1600hrs game drives or a full day game drive in search of wildlife with picnic lunch boxes. All meals and overnight stay Mara Leisure Camp (B/L/D)

Masai Mara offers an absolutely unique variety of animals. The reason is that this hilly region is both humid and fertile, and is crossed by the Mara and Talek rivers, full of crocodiles and hippos. The abundance of water and excellent

availability of food are the reasons why the Masai Mara, which in fact is a continuation of the Tanzanian Serengeti National Park, has the greatest population of wild animals in the whole of Africa. There is a particularly dramatic "spectacle" from July to October, the annual migration of huge herds of Gnus and zebras. Predators such as Hyenas, Jackals, Leopards and Lions of course, closely follow these herds. Gigantic herds of over 200 buffaloes can also be observed. (B/L/D)

OPTIONAL (Hot air balloon taking off in the beautiful early morning, you drift above the browsing game and have tremendous opportunities for unusual photographs)

DAY 04: Masai Mara

Full day spent in the Mara with early morning 0630hrs and afternoon 1600hrs game drives or a full day game drive in search of wildlife with picnic lunch boxes. All meals and overnight stay Mara Leisure Camp

Masai Mara offers an absolutely unique variety of animals. The reason is that this hilly region is both humid and fertile, and is crossed by the Mara and Talek rivers, full of crocodiles and hippos. The abundance of water and excellent availability of food are the reasons why the Masai Mara, which in fact is a continuation of the Tanzanian Serengeti National Park, has the greatest population of wild animals in the whole of Africa. (B/L/D)

DAY 05: Masai Mara -Lake Naivasha (approximately 5 ½ Hours)

After breakfast, travel into the Great Rift Valley to Lake Naivasha a beautiful fresh water lake, fringed by thick papyrus. Check in and have lunch. The shallow lake is almost 13 kms wide and its waters draw a great range of game to its shores. Giraffes are often seen wandering among the acacia, buffalo wallow in the swamps and Colobus monkeys call from the treetops while the Lake's large hippo population sleeps the day out its waters. Sunsets are stunning; with the haunting call of a Fish Eagle high over the lake bringing the day to a perfect end. Dinner and overnight at Lake Naivasha Country Club (B/L/D)

DAY 06: Lake Naivasha - Nairobi - Departure

After breakfast at the club depart for Nairobi. Proceed for the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your onward flight (B)

**Day 01: Arrive At Kilimanjaro (Jro) - Transfer To Arusha**

Meet and greet on arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport. Receive a short briefing about your safari which gives you a clear idea about the places you are going to visit as well as the accommodation arrangements. Proceed for Arusha hotel for overnight stay.

Day 02: Arusha - Tarangire National Park

After Breakfast depart with your naturalist driver/guide and picnic-lunch to Tarangire National Park, Tanzania's third largest National Park and Sanctuary to see a large elephant population. Game Drives inside the National Park. In the afternoon continue to your camp with arrival for dinner.

Day 03: Tarangire Region - Lake Manyara National Park - Karatu

In the morning guided bush walk to Lake Burunge. Continue with picnic-lunch to Lake Manyara National Park for Game Drives. With the Lake on its east and the Manyara Escarpment to its west the Lake Manyara National Park offers breathtaking views and a large variety of habitats - acacia woodlands, water forests, baobab strewn duffs, algae-streaked hot springs, swamps and the lake itself. In the afternoon continue to Karatu to visit the market and surroundings.

Day 04: Karatu - Olduvai Gorge - Serengeti National Park

After breakfast depart with picnic-lunch to Central Serengeti. The drive leads through Ngorongoro Highlands with a stop at Olduvai Gorge to visit the Museum. In the afternoon first Game Drive in Serengeti National Park. The Serengeti is home to Africa's Big Five with over 6,000 square miles of sprawling, unspoiled landscape. Add to that an extraordinary population of resident and migratory animals in a constant bid for survival, and you understand why this is often called, "the world as it was in the beginning." Wildlife viewing begins as soon as you enter the park - with leopards and lions, zebra, wildebeest and elephants!!

Day 05: Serengeti National Park

Morning and afternoon Game Drives in Serengeti National Park. Serengeti, together with Kenya's Masai Mara Game Reserve, forms Africa's most famous wildlife parks. The annual wildebeest migration through both of these parks, is the largest mass movement of land mammals on the planet - with more than a million animals following the rain. But that is not where the game viewing ends: large prides of lions, elephants and giraffes in the grassland, gazelles and elands just to mention a few. In the afternoon return to your camp and enjoy a private sundowner with your group.



Day 06: Serengeti National Park - Ngorongoro Crater - Karatu

In the morning depart with picnic-lunch to Ngorongoro Crater. Descent into the Crater to view game on the vast grasslands of the crater floor. Spectacular animal life can be found throughout the year due to the permanent availability of grass and water. Local wildlife includes black maned lion, the highly endangered black rhino, wildebeest, zebra, elephant, hippo, jackal, and hyena. In the afternoon continue towards Karatu.

Day 07: Karatu - Arusha - Departure After breakfast guided farm walk with an introduction to the cultivation of coffee. Return with picnic-lunch to Arusha with arrival in the early afternoon. Get transferred to Kilimanjaro Airport to catch your onward flight.



Day 01: Cape Town

Upon arrival at Cape Town International Airport, a representative meets you for a transfer to your pre-booked hotel.

Cape Town is one of the most popular long haul destinations of the world. Due to its unique topography, it is also one of the easiest places in which to orientate oneself and know that the Table Mountain is behind you and Robben Island before you; you are facing north, looking across Table Bay and up the west coast of Africa. Overnight at hotel.

Day 02: Cape Town - City Tour

After breakfast leave on a half-day Mother City tour.

You will go for a scenic coastal drive through Clifton and Sea Point, later passing the Houses of Parliament, the Castle, the SA Museum and a few other historical sights - District Six, Bo-Kaap, Slave Lodge and finally ending at the bustling Green Market Square. A cable car ride, takes you up the Table Mountain (weather permitting otherwise Signal Hill) for a breathtaking view over the city (entrance is included). Return to hotel for overnight stay.

Day 03: Cape Town - Peninsula Tour

After breakfast depart from the hotel on a full day Peninsula tour.

This comprehensive tour shows you the best of the spectacular Cape Peninsula and why it is called the Fairest Cape. Travel past Sea Point and Camps Bay, past the famous beaches of Clifton and Llandudno towards Hout Bay. Drive along the Atlantic Seaboard. Pass through Noordhoek and Scarborough.

Later proceed for the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve. Enjoy the funicular ride aboard the "Flying Dutchman" and enjoy the unforgettable spectacular views. Good photo opportunity to take some pictures at the second southern most tip of the African continent. Visit the beautiful Boulders Beach and have the option to sit among the famous colony of Jackass Penguins. Thereafter we enjoy a short stop at the naval port of Simon's Town and know about the legend of "Able Seaman Just Nuisance" the Great Dane Dog that was inducted in Royal Navy. Return to the hotel for overnight stay.

Day 04: Cape Town - Oudtshoorn

After breakfast, check and transfer to Oudtshoorn. It is known as the 'Feather Capital of the World' thanks to its huge ostrich industry.

Arrive and in the afternoon enjoy a tour of the Wildlife Ranch where you will visit a crocodile Park where you have opportunity to take pictures with Cheetah. Check into hotel and

spend rest of evening in the comfort of your hotel with overnight stay.

Day 05: Oudtshoorn - Knysna

After breakfast leave on a tour of the Congo Caves - In Oudtshoorn you go underground to marvel at the icy formations in the Congo Caves, regarded as one of South Africa's most spectacular natural wonders. Enjoy a tour of the Ostrich Farm before your transfer to Knysna.

Arrive in Knysna and go on a cruise on the vast Knysna Lagoon. Enjoy an amazing view of the imposing sandstone 'Heads' which guard the sea entrance to Knysna's huge tidal lagoon, and the forests, marshes and pristine beaches surrounding it. Evening, check into the hotel.

Day 06: Knysna - George - Johannesburg - Sun City

After breakfast transfer to George airport to board a flight to Johannesburg. On arrival you are met by a representative for a transfer to Sun City.

The Sun City complex is surrounded by two championship golf courses, numerous swimming pools and a huge man made lake offering various water sports. **Optional activities include Hot Air Ballooning.**

You could relax at the Valley of the Waves, or take a walk through the gardens of the Lost City. This magical city knows no limits - you have the chance to win a fortune at the Casino and Entertainment Centre. There are lavish extravaganzas and a multitude of restaurants to cater for every taste. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 07: Sun City

After breakfast you will enjoy your day at leisure. Optional game drives to Pilanesberg Nature Reserve to see the Big 5. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 08: Sun City - Kruger

After breakfast transfer to Kruger National Park.

The Kruger National Park in South Africa is one of its oldest and largest reserves. The park boasts of a tremendous variety of game, the Big 5 and bird life in its numerous habitats. You should see: elephant, giraffe, zebra, buffalo, warthog, lion, spotted hyenas, baboon, hippo, impala, kudu, vervet monkey, waterbuck, Tsessebe, wildebeest, bush baby, mongoose, duiker, steenbok, klipspringer, genet, bats. You may see: leopard, wild dog, cheetah, roan antelope, sable antelope, bat-eared fox, rhino, honey badger, porcupine, rebook, aardvark, aardwolf, civet, and caracal and serval suni. Arrive and check in the lodge. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 09: Kruger National Park

Enjoy a full day game drive. Overnight at hotel.

Day 10: Kruger National Park - Johannesburg

After breakfast depart for Johannesburg. On arrival you will be transferred to the hotel. Overnight at hotel.

Day 11: Johannesburg

After breakfast leave for a Gold Reef City tour (Closed on Mondays and Tuesdays).

Where you will see reconstruction of Johannesburg during the Gold Rush era, built around a mine. Activities include a Victorian





fun fair, miners' houses, brewery, pubs, restaurants and stock exchange. You can watch molten gold being poured and take a trip down an old mine shaft. Tribal dancing adds to the fun. Return to hotel for overnight stay.

Day 12: Johannesburg

After breakfast, transfer to Or Tambo

Day 01: Apt / Casablanca

Arrival at Casablanca Mohamed V Airport, meet and greet and transfer to hotel for check in and overnight stay.

Day 02: Casablanca / Rabat

After breakfast proceed by 09.30 on a sightseeing tour of Casablanca, the business capital of the kingdom. From your coach you'll see the Medina, Mohammed V square, United Nations square, the Central Market, the Habbous quarter, the Royal Palace, the residential area of Anfa and the outside view of the magnificent Hassan II Mosque and the Ain Diab Cornice lined with swimming pools and gastronomic restaurants. Lunch at leisure.

Afternoon depart for Rabat the administrative capital of Morocco. Sightseeing of the "Imperial Garden City" with its main monuments: Oudayas garden, Hassan Tower and Mausoleum. You'll also see the ramparts and walls of the Medhwar which surround the Royal Palace. Late afternoon arrival at hotel for check-in, dinner and overnight stay.

Day 03: Rabat / Meknes / Fes

Breakfast followed by departure to Meknes and a tour of this "Moroccan Versailles" which was founded at the end of the 17th century by Moulay Ismail, a contemporary of Louis XIV. Additional sightseeing includes Bab El Mansour, considered as the finest gateway in Morocco. Lunch at leisure in Meknes or Moulay Idriss the holy city or facing Volubilis ruins. Continue to FES to check in at hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 04: FES

After breakfast, the whole day will be devoted to discovering Fes, the oldest of the Imperial Cities, which is well known for its spiritual and educational contributions to the Moroccan culture. Visit of the



medieval Medina. You will also explore the famous souks where craftsmen still work in the age-old oriental tradition. Lunch at leisure. Continue sightseeing in the afternoon. Return to hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 05: Fes / Marrakech [470 Km]

Early wake-up and after breakfast, departure for Marrakech via Immouzer du Kandar, a Berber village, Ifrane, a delightful ski resort and Azrou, a Berber village known for its handicraft - wood carving and carpet weaving. Lunch at leisure in Beni Mellal, then continuation to Marrakech. By end of afternoon arrive in Marrakech and check-in to hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 06: Marrakech

After breakfast, the entire day will be devoted to sightseeing in Marrakech, the second oldest Imperial City and definitely the "Pearl of the South".

Founded by

the Almoravides at the end of the 11th century, Marrakech sits in a lush oasis nestling at the foot of the snow-capped Atlas Mountains. You will visit the famous Saadian Tombs, Menara Gardens, Koutoubia mosque, and Bahia Palace. After lunch at the hotel, continue with sightseeing in the souks and the famous Jemaa El Fna square. Return to your hotel for overnight stay.

Day 07: Marrakech - Casablanca [250 Km]

You will have the morning free to do whatever you like, whether it be shopping at the fabulous souks or simply relaxing by the poolside at your hotel. Lunch at leisure in Marrakech. Departure for Casablanca. Dinner and overnight stay at hotel.

Day 08: Casablanca - Apt

After breakfast, transfer to airport for your return flight.



Day 01: Beijing

Arrive at Beijing Capital International Airport. Airport pick up with our English-speaking airport representative, transfer to hotel and relax and enjoy your day at leisure.

Day 02: Beijing

We start the City tour with a visit to the Summer Palace, the largest and best preserved of all the imperial palace gardens, and boasts such delights as the "Marble Boat" and the ornately painted "Long Corridor" and visit the Pearl shop.

We continue our tour with a visit to the world famous Tian'anmen Square, the biggest square in the world that lies in the center of the city. Visit the Forbidden City from which the Emperors of the Ming and Qing dynasties governed China for over 500 years. Today we also have optional activity: Hutong tour, which is also called Rickshaw Tour.

Visit Houhai, is a lake and its surrounding district in central Beijing, one of the three parts of Shichahai. In recent years it has become famous for nightlife because it is home to many popular restaurants, bars, and cafes. The area is especially popular with foreign tourists visiting Beijing, but is also often visited by the expatriate community and younger locals.

Transfer to a restaurant for dinner and then back to hotel for overnight stay.

Day 03: Beijing/Xian

Departure from hotel by 10:00 to start City tour. Visit a Longdi Jade shop where we will learn about Chinese jade culture. Visit the fabled Great Wall-Juyong Pass, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a massive defensive structure built to keep off intrusion.

Afternoon proceed to see the Bird's Nest (Olympic National Stadium from outside) and the Water Cube (from outside). Transfer to railway station to take overnight train to Xian.

Day 04: Xian - Arrive at 0809 by Z19

By 0800am Arrive at Shanghai Hongqiao Railway Station. Pick up and transfer to hotel with early check-in subject to hotel room availability. Proceed for City tour and visit the incredible 2000 year-old Terra Cotta



Warriors. Each one is part of the underground tomb of the Emperor Qin. Well over 7000 figures were drawn up in full battle array in several large pits.

Ceramic shop.

Afternoon, visit the **Shaanxi Historical Museum**. Among the 400,000 items on display are treasures from many of the Dynasties, including some magnificent bronzes and porcelain, many of which have never been on permanent display before. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 05 : Xi'an/Shanghai [Overnight Train]-

Early noon proceed on City tour. Visit the Big Wild Goose Pagoda square. The great goose pagoda, calling Dayanta in Chinese, is built for keeping book. You can watch the **Bell and Drum tower outside look**, a classical building with carved beams and painted rafters, has been served as the symbol of Xi'an. The Muslim Bazaar, the Muslim quarters lies 100 meters west of the Bell tower in downtown Xi'an. The 500 meters long avenue paved by bluestones are dotted with many unique stall, souvenir shop, café and bars which are mostly run by Muslim people.

Overnight Train to Shanghai-by Z91/Z94 1700/0653+1 soft berth Transfer to train station to take overnight train to Shanghai.

Day 06: Shanghai-Arrive at 0653 by Z91/Z94

Early morning by 0653am, arrive Shanghai railway station. Pick up and transfer to hotel, early check-in subject to room availability. As soon possible we departure from Hotel and start our city tour.

Visit silk shop, the Shanghai Museum which is the largest museum of ancient Chinese art in Shanghai. Visit the People Square and Nanjing Road for shopping. Visit the lovely old Yuyuan Garden-outside look nine zig zag bridge with golden fish pond, bridges and pavilions.

Step onto Yu Market (Old City God's Temple), which is a major yet relatively inactive, Taoist temple in Shanghai. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 07: Shanghai

Today we visit the Jade Buddha Temple, the most famous Buddhist temple in Shanghai, Tea Shop, then transfer to Taobao City for shopping. Explore the Bund in the evening. Visit the Oriental Pearl TV tower 2nd level

Option program: Huangpu River Cruise

Day 08: Shanghai back

Breakfast at hotel, free time for leisure before 1200. Transfer to airport by noon to get international flight, **option:** Maglev Train one way to Pudong Airport.



Day 01: Arrival in Bali

Arrival at Bali International Airport, meet and greet service and transfer to hotel. Rest of day is free at leisure. In the evening enjoy the dinner with traditional performance at local restaurant.

Overnight at the hotel.

Day 02: Full Day Kintamani Tour

The perfect introduction to Bali's fascinating culture and magnificent handicrafts, view picturesque rice paddy fields, traditional villages and a spectacular lake and volcano. Then continue on through the woodcarving village of Mas. Watch artisans chipping intricate designs from wood blocks. Then visit the fantastic 11th century Elephant Cave (Goa Gajah) and the holy-spring temple in Tampak Siring before moving into the cool mountains of Kintamani.

View Mount Baturan active volcano with its ribbons of black lava running down its peak to the valley below. Beside lies the shimmering lake of Batur. Enjoy lunch in a restaurant providing wonderful views. In the evening transfer to local restaurant for enjoy your dinner. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 03: Water Activities & Romantic Sunset Dinner Cruise

At your convenient time, you will be picked up from the hotel and transferred to Tanjung Benoa beach. Here, you will enjoy the water sport activities such as parasailing, jetski, and banana boat ride. Indonesian lunch will be provided at local restaurant. Afterward return to the hotel for preparing the next program.

Late afternoon, you will be picked up from your hotel and transfer to Benoa harbor. There's no better way to spend a balmy tropical evening than on Bali Hai's evening Dinner Cruise. As the sun goes down we set off on a relaxing cruise around the harbor. Later visit the Eagle Square and end the tour at the duty-free Kuah Town. Perfume stores, cigar shops, confectioner outlets, wine boutiques and other retail venues are abundant in this quarter of Langkawi Island. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 03: Langkawi At Leisure

Enjoy your morning breakfast with full day at leisure. Overnight at hotel in Langkawi.

Day 04: Langkawi - Kuala Lumpur

Enjoy your morning breakfast and check out from hotel. Transfers to Langkawi airport to catch your flight to Kuala Lumpur. Meet and greet at Kuala Lumpur airport and directly transfer to city. Check in at hotel in Kuala Lumpur. Free at leisure. Overnight at hotel.

Day 05: Kuala Lumpur City Tour

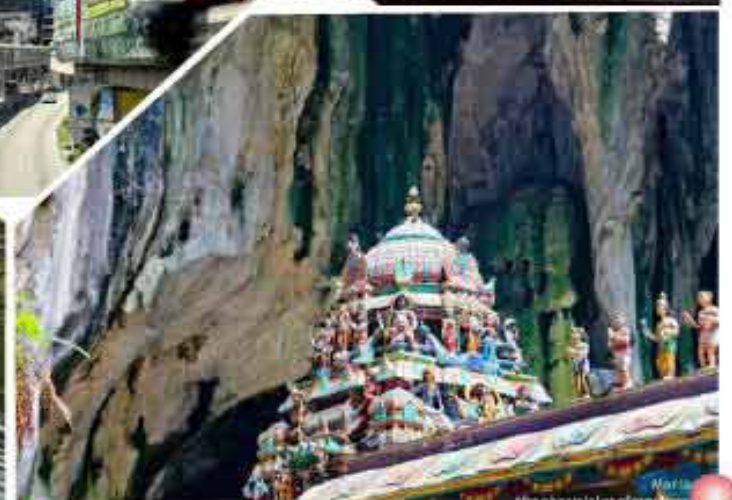

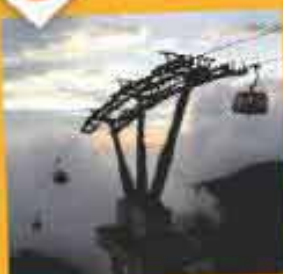

DAY 07: Ho Chi Minh City Departure - arrival Phnom Penh - Royal Palace

After breakfast transfer to bus station and proceed for Phnom Penh. Pick up by our local guide and driver and transfer to hotel for check-in. Visit the magnificent Royal Palace, the famous sacred Silver Pagoda and the Elephant Museum. Visit Central Market - known as Phsar Thmey, a beautiful art-deco building constructed in 1930s by French architect Louis Chauchon. At this market you can find almost everything on sale from bargain garment products to fresh seafood.

Visit the Independence Monument and continue along Norodom Boulevard to the historical and sacred site of Wat Phnom, a man-made historical hill found in 1372 which the city name Phnom Penh is derived from. Stroll along the riverfront to see activities of locals relaxing after the day. Overnight in Phnom Penh.

DAY 08: Transfer To Siem Reap - Free At Leisure

After breakfast, check-out from hotel and transfer to the Airport for Siem Reap [flight on own]. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel for check-in. Free at leisure. Overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 09: Sunrise/angkor Wat/angkor Thom/tapohm/banteay Srei

Rise early morning to watch sunrise at Angkor

Wat. Continue exploring the mysterious Royal city of Angkor Thom. The 54-tower temple of Bayon is an awesome sight with hundreds of smiling faces of Avalokiteshvara. Then visit the surroundings of the complex including the Baphuon, Elephant Terrace, Leper King Terrace and Royal Palace. Ta Prohm.

In the afternoon continue to Banteay Srei, a beautiful pink-sandstone temple famously known for its fine carving. Visit Banteay Samre, also built by Surya Vaman II - the mastermind behind Angkor Wat. In the evening, you will enjoy a dinner with Khmer Traditional Dance Show. Overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 10: Siem Reap Departure

Today you are free until transfer to airport for taking your flight back home.

Day 6: Taroko Gorge

Take your adventure to the next level as you river trace in the Taroko Gorge. Truly the best way to enjoy the view, you will combine climbing and hiking in the picturesque (and safe) environment. Visit the Changchun Shrine, or the Eternal Spring Shrine. The shrine commemorates the 212 construction workers who died building the Central Cross-Island Highway. Visit the Shullian Cave, or the Water Curtain Cave. Before your journey ends, hike the Shakadang Trail, or Mysterious Valley Trail, built along the river's edge, and get one last glimpse of the postcard-perfect views.

Day 7: East Coast Scenic Area

Day 01: Arrival Kathmandu

Meeting at airport Transfer to hotel. Kathmandu is the capital of Nepal and the Kathmandu Valley is the political and cultural heart of the Kingdom. The urban sprawl that makes up modern Kathmandu is in fact two cities, Patan and Kathmandu.

Day 06: Pokhara

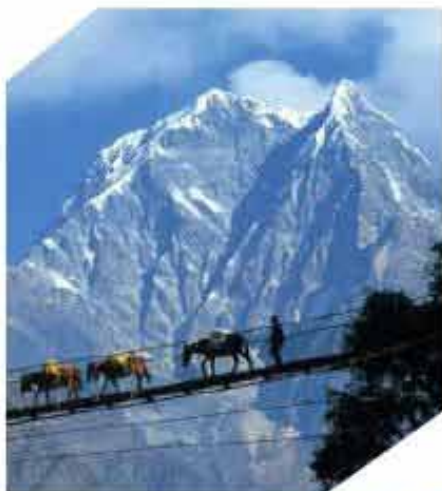

Jumeirah, the address favored by palaces and opulent residences is next on the itinerary. The picturesque Jumeirah Mosque is one of the most beautiful modern Islamic constructions the city can boast of and is a dash of the new before you can visit Al Bastakiya. This locality is part of Dubai's quaint old quarter and houses the famous Al Fahidi Fort, now converted into a museum.

Afternoon-Evening: A desert safari drive is organized to round off an exciting day spent in shops and malls. The routes are noted for their captivating views of the deserts outlying Dubai, especially during sunsets and make for an enjoyable ride. is considered to be among the top ten Dubai attractions. It is ideally located in Jumeirah, very close to the Burj Al Arab. Wild Wadi Dubai is a popular water theme park with several options for entertainment and fun. It has a wave pool, along with several water slides as well as artificial surfing machines. It has one of the largest water slides that are located in the region. There are three restaurants where the visitors can order for sumptuous meals. 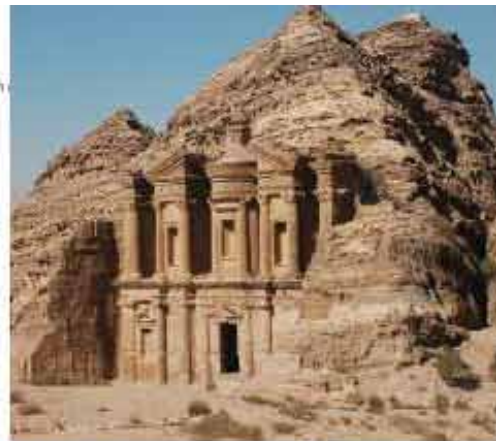

wonders and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Enter the city through 1KM long narrow gorge which is flanked either side by 80m high cliffs! Notice the dazzling colors and formations of the rocks. The site is massive, and contains hundreds of elaborated rock-cut tombs, a treasury, Roman-style theatres, temples, sacrificial altars and colonnaded streets. Overnight stay in Petra (BB).

DAY 05: PETRA-WADIRUM-DEAD SEA

After breakfast, we head further down in southern Jordan to visit other significant sites including Wadi Rum to explore Wadi Rum on a 1.30 hour jeep ride into the Jordanian desert! Wadi Rum was best described by T.E. Lawrence as "Vast, echoing and god-like", and by the locals as "Valley of the Moon". Proceed to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth.

Overnight stay at the Dead Sea (BB).

DAY 06: DEPARTURE DEAD SEA

After breakfast, transfer to Queen Alia International Airport for departure to your final destination.

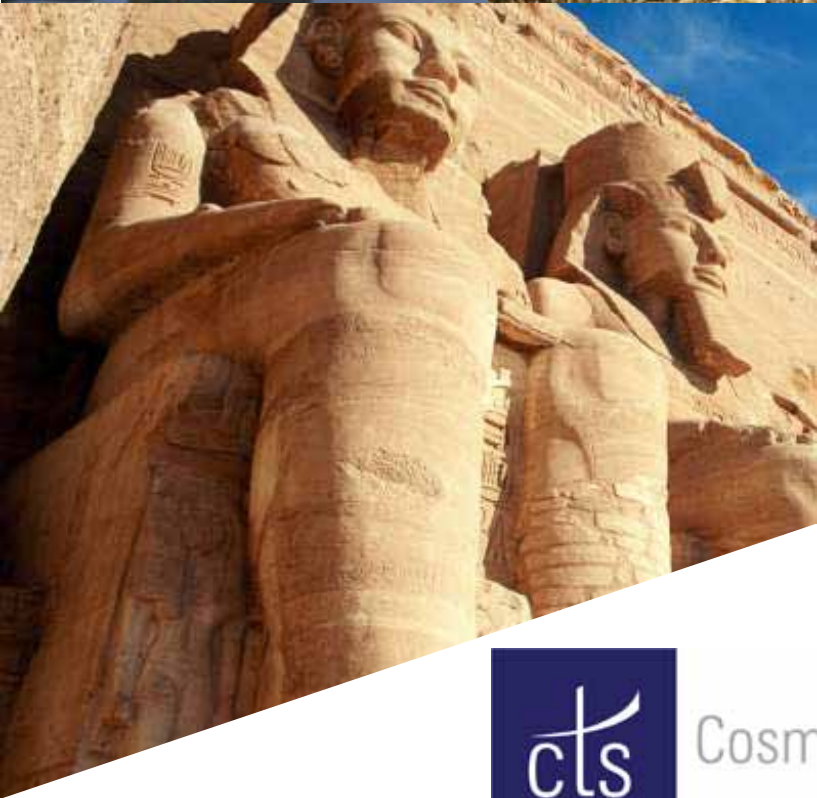
